Public Participation in the 2015—2019 Consolidated Plans

The Delaware State Housing Authority (DSHA), New Castle County, City of Wilmington and City of Dover will all be submitting new Consolidated Plans for 2015—2019 in May, 2015.

The Consolidated Plan is required by the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to determine uses of federal housing funds, and identifies priority housing needs, strategies, and goals for a jurisdiction for the coming five years.

Citizen feedback on needs and priorities in the fall of 2014 will be considered in the development of draft plans. The draft plans will be released in April 2015 for a 30-day public comment period and additional public hearings on the drafts.
