Bids are being sought from contractors to provide all labor, materials, equipment, and services required for the completion of particular items in the Summercrest Community. The project scope involves the completion of new sidewalks and handicap access ramps and the repair of existing catch basins, curbing, sidewalk and sidewalk aprons. It will also include adjusting existing water valves and manholes and repairs to existing road base and final paving of all roadways.
